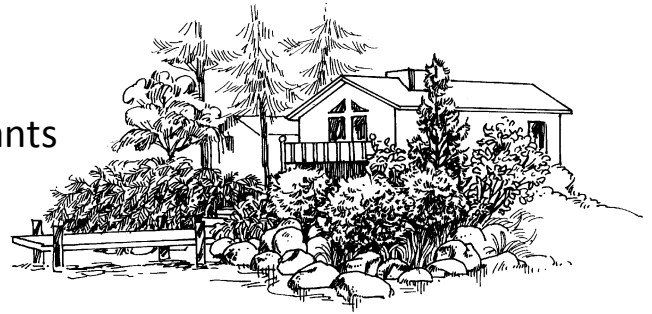


Shoreland Landscaping - Planting Workshop on Dam Lake

Location: Dam Lake. From Aitkin take HWY 47 East to County Road 4 . Turn left onto County Road 4 and proceed approximately 3 miles to County Road 53. Turn left onto County Road 53 and proceed north for 1 mile to 350th Lane. Turn right onto 350th Lane and proceed a half mile to the fork. Take the left fork. The workshop is at the first house. (29243 350th Lane)
